

HFSA SOLOIST QUALIFICATIONS 2012 SPRING ICE SHOW

revised November 2010

Achieving a solo (up to 8 solos maximum) in the annual March ice show is a privilege and an honor. A solo will be awarded to those skaters who receive the most points in a season. Points will be accumulated on an annual basis from December 1 – November 30.

***5 MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR A SOLO**

1. HFSA member for the entire Fall/winter season.
2. Contract for a minimum of three (3) Fall/winter Hutchinson ice sessions. Includes: Group Lessons, Practice Ice, and Sunday PRCE Ice.
3. Skater must be a skating member of HFSA, which means they must skate their weekly ice time. (HFSA Director's discretion.)
4. Skater must have achieved the level of Freestyle 5 (passed this level).
5. Skater must participate in two (2) ISI/ USFSA competitions and one (1) HFSA solo exhibition. Or skater must participate in three (3) ISI/ USFSA competitions.

After the 5 minimum requirements are met, points will be accumulated as follows:

1. LAST LEVEL PASSED -Skaters will be awarded points based on the last level they passed.

2. HOLIDAY ON ICE OR EXHIBITION Participation = 5 points

A skater will be awarded 5 points for participation in either the Holiday on Ice or an Exhibition show. 5 points maximum earned per year.

3. COMPETITION POINTS - ISI OR USFSA

For the first event 1 point will be awarded per competition, additional events in the same competition will each count as 1 point, with a maximum of 2 points awarded per competition.

Effective December 1st, 2009 for points towards the 2011 show: Testing for Freestyle 7 and above, at competitions, will be awarded 2 points. A maximum of 2 points total will be awarded per competition combining/including both events and testing.

4. CONTRACTED ICE - Hutchinson Ice Only

1 point per session for fall/winter HFSA ice time and Sunday morning PRCE practice ice with a maximum of 4 points award for the fall/winter season.

1/2 point per HFSA session for summer ice, with a maximum of 2 points awarded per summer.

5. YEARS SKATING AS AN HFSA MEMBER

Starting with the 2000/2001 season, each skater who was an HFSA member for the entire season, received 1 point. Each year as an HFSA skating member, the skater will earn an additional point. This is the only cumulative point from year to year.

IN THE EVENT OF A TIE:

- The Solo will be awarded to the skater at the highest ISI level.
- If the skaters are at the same ISI level, the solo will be awarded to the oldest skater.
